If you have a bunch add to your post, you can think of hiding them further in your caption. This way, you can attract more followers without overwhelming people reading your post. To give you your you can choose to add it as a comment to the post, or you can add line breaks to rely on your hashtags in your caption. Here's how to do it: Use your iPhone's notes app. Save all your hashtags in one paragraph. I use Notes on iOS. Put down five or so periods on the list, each with a new line break. Then add all your hashtags at the bottom of those periods. Now you can copy and paste them whenever you need it. Thanks to a new feature in Instagram, you can now follow specific hashtags and get the top posts for that hashtag to appear in their main feed. Here's how to make it happen. Start by opening the Instagram app and tapping the search tab at the bottom. Tap the search bar at the top. Type a hashtag that you want to follow, and make sure the Tags tab is selected. You might get a pop-up that tells you about this new feature. Press Next if it appears. After selecting a hashtag, you can tap the blue Follow button at the top. Once you start following a hashtag, you'll start seeing top posts of that hashtag in your main feed, indicated with the hashtag in the title, along with the user who posted it. You'll also see some of the latest stories that that hashtag appears in your stories bar. To see a list of all the hashtags you follow, go to your profile page and tap Next. After that, tap the Hashtags tab at the top. A list will appear of all the hashtags you follow. From here, you can also tap Next next to a hashtag to follow it up at any time. Keep in mind that hashtags you follow are visible to everyone else. If you set your account to private, only people who follow will see it. Emoji are those little Japanese picture icons that people use to complement their written text content on social media and in text messages. Last but not least, the last way you can take advantage of emoji hashtags on Instagram is by navigating to the Search tab (characterized by using the magnifying glass icon in the lower menu) and the search field at the top. Tap the search field to start your search, and make sure you type Hashtags so that it's highlighted in blue (as opposed to People). From there, simply type the emoji into the search field, without typing the '#' in front of it. For example, typing a single pizza emoji in the search field has nearly 7,000 mail results when we searched looking for it.
